All students (including on-campus, face-to-face) should have access to at least a basic computer. On campus students *may* be able to use computer labs.

<sup>1</sup> Interior Design students should be able to run required software on a Windows(OS) laptop with a price point of about \$900 for the duration of the program.

Architectural Animation and Virtual Reality students should have ongoing access to a gaming computer. Do not buy a new computer if you already have one before checking the specs sent to you by the program. We have allowed \$3000 in books/supplies costs to cover this cost – you will not be required to purchase this if your computer is sufficient.

<sup>2</sup> Engineering technology programs - laptop costs are currently being estimated at \$2500 and this is included in the books and supplies total in year 1.

<sup>3</sup> Administrative Office Professional students are expected to have access to a Windows computer - \$900 has been included in the books and supplies cost total but students may already own something sufficient so they should check with the program before purchasing.

<sup>4</sup> After-degree nursing students take one 3 credit class at the U of L - ~\$900 has been added to the supplies cost and will be displayed on the Student Aid Alberta loan application but students must pay the university themselves - the college cannot charge this or remit it to the university on behalf of students.

<sup>5</sup> **Practical Nursing** students must pay for CPNRE exams after program completion - these costs are not part of the college program. Health Care Aid and Medical Device Reprocessing students also write an exam after their program. These costs are not included in this estimate nor are they covered by Student Loans. PN students must also purchase a mobile learning device at the cost of approx. \$1,000.

<sup>6</sup> Students will be charged a medical/dental benefit fee unless they opt out by demonstrating alternative coverage - deadlines can be found at http://mylcsa.com/services/health-dental. Students are also charged a\$20 annual fee for the LCSA Legal Plan; instructions for opting out will be available on the my.lcsa website.

<sup>7</sup> International tuition is domestic rate (2nd year + 10%), **plus \$326/credit**. Pathway to English and Academic Culture costs above are per semester and include 1 GNS course and field trips **plus \$175/credit**.

<sup>8</sup> **Digital Communications and Media** students are required to have a laptop that meets program specifications as well as other specialized equipment - specifications for these items will be sent to students. A mid-range cost for each item has been included here. Students without adequate computer can expect to pay about \$1600-\$2000 for a suitable machine--this is included in the supplies estimate - so if student has this on hand their costs will be that much less. **Multimedia production** students should have access to a computer that meets program specifications - supplies costs allow for the purchase of a sufficient computer but students should check with the program before purchase - labs are available at the college as well.

<sup>9</sup> 'Supplies' includes \$250 to help offset costs associated with the capstone course and/or related research.

<sup>10</sup> Primary Care Paramedic students are required to have an iPad running iOS11 or greater; a cost of \$1,000 was added into 'supplies' to account for this.
