ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPANTS IN CONVOCATION CEREMONY STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE > LETHBRIDGE COLLEGE

A: Eligibility for Participation in Convocation:

- 1. Lethbridge College has defined graduation requirements as listed in the published academic calendar for each program which also determines convocation eligibility.
- 2. Students who have successfully fulfilled their program requirements by the following dates are eligible to participate in convocation ceremonies:

Completed Program Requirements By:	Convocation Ceremony:
September 1 - April 30	Spring (May)
May 1 – August 31	Fall (October)

- 3. Eligibility is specified as a student who has successfully completed the necessary courses to fulfill their program requirements for graduation as stipulated in the Lethbridge College calendar and as defined by the Graduation Requirements Policy.
- 4. In the event of the death of a student who met Convocation eligibility, a family member may participate in the Convocation ceremony in his/her stead.
- 5. The following Lethbridge College credentials are eligible to participate in convocation:
