## **EL-14 – Environmental Stewardship**

The president shall not permit the college to be managed in a manner inconsistent with stewardship of the environment.

Further, without limiting the scope of the above statement by the following list, the president shall not:

1. Allow the college to violate any applicable laws, regulations or bylaws relating to the environment.
2. Allow the college to be without contingency plans for reasonably foreseeable environmental emergencies.
3. Permit untimely or inefficient resolutions of environmental infractions.
4. Use energy inefficient systems in new construction and projects, unless cost-prohibitive
5. Allow any major acquisition that is not consistent with environmental sustainability.
6. Permit college operations that do not support the principles of “reduce, reuse, recycle, and recover”, where practicable.
7. Allow activities that have the potential to destroy or severely impair the natural environment or ecosystem of the grounds of the college campus.
8. Permit the board to be without timely information regarding any environmental infractions or emergencies.
