## **EL-14 – Environmental Stewardship**

The president shall not permit the college to be managed in a manner inconsistent with stewardship of the environment.

Further, without limiting the scope of the above statement by the following list, the president shall not:

- 1. Allow the college to violate any applicable laws, regulations or bylaws relating to the environment.
- 2. Allow the college to be without contingency plans for reasonably foreseeable environmental emergencies.
- 3. Permit untimely or inefficient resolutions of environmental infractions.
- 4. Use energy inefficient systems in new construction and projects, unless cost-prohibitive
- 5. Allow any major acquisition that is not consistent with environmental sustainability.
- 6. Permit college operations that do not support the principles of "reduce, reuse, recycle, and recover", where practicable.
- 7. Allow activities that have the potential to destroy or severely impair the natural environment or ecosystem of the grounds of the college campus.
- 8. Permit the board to be without timely information regarding any environmental infractions or emergencies.
