Practical Nurse Diploma Competitive Entry Points Chart

How to use:

- 1. Determine which level of English and Math you have completed.*
- 2. Determine the final percentage in each of Biology, English and Math.*
- 3. For each of these courses, apply the points that corresponds with each level and percentage. This score will give you your competitive entry mark.

As an example:

Jody has completed BIO 30 with a final grade of 82%: Points = 20 Jody has completed ENG 30-2 with a final grade of 76%: Points = 10 Jody has completed MTH 30-1 with a final grade of 82%: Points = 20 Total Points: 50

Mature applicants (those who are or will be 19 years of age or older by the last day of the term in which they applied) are eligible to complete Lethbridge College's Accuplacer testing to meet the English and/or Math admission requirements OR to attempt to receive higher competitive entry points in English and/or Math.

Scores from Accuplacer testing will be converted into competitive entry points for admission, with the higher points option for each subject area being used (high school grades, post-secondary course grades, or Accuplacer testing results).
