All students (including on-campus, face-to-face) should have access to at least a basic computer. On campus students may be able to use computer labs.

¹ **Interior Design** students should be able to run required software on a Windows(OS) laptop with a price point of about \$750 for the duration of the program. Administrative Office Professional students should be able to get by with the same price point -- many students will already own such a machine.

Architectural Animation and Virtual Reality students should have ongoing access to a gaming computer. Do not buy a new computer if you already have one before checking the specs sent to you by the program. We have allowed \$2400 in books/supplies costs to cover this purchase – you will not be required to spend this if your computer is sufficient.

² **Engineering** technology programs - laptop costs are currently being estimated at \$2500 and this is included in the books and supplies total in year 1. Students will also be required to purchase a \$50 drawing kit.

³ **Culinary Arts** students are charged a damage deposit fee for their 'whites' of \$160. This deposit is rolled over in year 2 to cover professional uniforms as long as original whites are returned.

⁴ **After-degree nursing** students take one 3 credit class at the U of L - this ~\$900 has been added to the supplies cost and will be displayed on the Student Aid Alberta loan application but students must pay the university themselves - the college cannot charge this or remit it to the university on behalf of students.

⁵ **Practical Nursing** students must pay for CPNRE exams after program completion - these costs are not part of the college program. Health Care Aid and Medical Device Reprocessing students also write an exam after their program. Because these costs are not a part of the College program, they are not allowed to be included but students should be aware of them.

⁶ Students will be charged a medical/dental benefit fee unless they opt out by demonstrating alternative coverage - deadlines can be found at <http://mylcsa.com/services/health-dental>. Students are also charged a \$20 annual fee for the LCSA Legal Plan; instructions for opting out will be available on the my.lcsa website.
