## Methodology

( P- Population The city of Lethbridge has a total population of 77,202 residents ( 2005 municipal census) approximately $79 \%$ of which are 18 years of age or older ( 61,250 est.). A total of 37,546 residents are male ( $48.6 \%$ ) while 39,656 are female ( $51.4 \%$ ). South Lethbridge is home to 27,894 residents ( $36.1 \%$ ) while the rapidly expanding west side is now home to 26,407 residents (34.2\%). There are 22,911 north Lethbridge residents (29.7\%).
(2. Sample Data were collected by Lethbridge Community College and Athabasca University students enrolled in STS270 - Social Science Research Methods at Lethbridge Community College in the fall of 2005. Students interviewed 584 adult residents of the city of Lethbridge on October $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }} 2005$ by telephone using the Western Wats Lethbridge call center facility. Telephone numbers were selected using random predictive dialing from a sample drawn from the Telus Superpages. We sincerely thank Western Wats for their hospitality.
Q. Representativeness Analysis of the demographic data indicates that, within acceptable limits, the sample accurately represents the demographic distribution of the adult population within the city of Lethbridge. The sample has been statistically weighted where necessary to even better reflect the demographic distribution of the population (gender and area of the city).
(. Confidence The weighted sample yields a margin of error of $\pm 4 \%, 19$ times out of 20 . The margin of error increases when analyzing sub-samples of the data.
(. Sponsorship These data are part of a larger study of the opinions and attitudes of Lethbridge residents conducted by the Citizen Society Research Lab at LCC. This particular set of questions was sponsored by Womanspace Resource Centre. We thank Womanspace for their support of our research endeavours.

## Womanspace Resource Centre

(. Overall, Lethbridge residents have a very limited knowledge of Womanspace Resource Centre. Only 1.8\% of all residents state that they are very knowledgeable while $12.0 \%$ claim to have some knowledge of Womanspace. One-quarter of all residents (25.1\%) say they have heard of Womanspace but are not sure what the centre does. More than three of every five Lethbridge residents (61.0\%) state that they have never heard of the Womanspace Resource Centre.
( Women are slightly more knowledgeable and aware of Womanspace than are men.
Q. West Lethbridge residents are considerably less aware of Womanspace than are south and north Lethbridge residents.
(. Upper income residents demonstrate slightly higher levels of knowledge than do middle and lower income residents.
Q. Higher educated residents are more knowledgeable than are lower educated residents
( L Lethbridge youth are the most likely to have never heard of Womanspace (73.9\%) while boomers indicate the greatest levels of awareness.

## Womanspace Resource Centre Issues and Objectives

(. Womanspace Resource Centre's mandate, goals and overall purpose resonate well with Lethbridge residents.

A Three-quarters of all residents (74.6\%) agree that more needs to be done to improve the status of women in Canada. Only $7.3 \%$ disagree while $18.1 \%$ neither agree nor disagree. Women (76.3\%) agree slightly more than do men (72.7\%) while west Lethbridge residents are less likely to agree and more likely to disagree than are south and north Lethbridge residents. Lower income and less educated residents are more supportive than are other income and education groups. Lethbridge youth are most supportive of doing more for improving the status of women in Canada, while gen-xers are less supportive.
(. Support for the Womanspace Resource Centre mandate is strong (74.2\%) and almost identical to that for improving the status of women in Canada. Only $6.5 \%$ are opposed to the Womanspace mandate while one-in-five Lethbridge residents are neither supportive nor opposed (19.2\%). Lower income residents (79.8\%), university grads (77.3\%) and the youth (81.7\%) are most supportive.
( A. Overall support for feminism (53.4\%) is considerably less than is support for improving the status of women or for the Womanspace mission. That being said, support for feminism is four times greater than is opposition (13.3\%) within the city of Lethbridge. One-third of all residents are neutral in their opinions of feminism. University grads (62.2\%) and seniors (61.4\%) are most supportive of feminism.
