## 2008 Lethbridge Public Opinion (Winter)

## Social Issues Report

February 2008

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## Methodology

(. Population The city of Lethbridge has a total population of 81,692 residents ( 2007 municipal census) approximately $80 \%$ of which are 18 years of age or older $(65,832)$. A total of 39,941 Lethbridge residents are male ( $48.9 \%$ ) while 41,751 are female (51.1\%). South Lethbridge is home to 29,225 residents ( $35.8 \%$ ) while the rapidly expanding west side is now home to 28,443 residents (34.8\%). There are 24,024 north Lethbridge residents (29.4\%).

1. Sample Data were collected by Lethbridge College students enrolled in STS270 - Social Science Research Methods in the winter of 2008. Students interviewed 502 adult city of Lethbridge residents by telephone on February 9 and 10, 2008. Telephone numbers were selected from a sample drawn from Info Canada directories. We sincerely appreciate and thank all those who took time out of their day to respond to our survey. ( Representativeness Analysis of the demographic data indicates that, within acceptable limits, the sample accurately represents the demographic distribution of the adult population within the city of Lethbridge. The sample has been statistically weighted where necessary to even better reflect the demographic distribution of the population (gender, age and area of the city of Lethbridge).
( - Confidence The weighted sample yields a margin of error of $\pm 4.4 \%, 19$ times out of 20 for the full winter 2008 Lethbridge sample and $\pm 6.2 \% 19$ times out of 20 for each of Lethbridge West ( $\mathrm{n}=256$ ) and Lethbridge East ( $n=246$ ). The margin of error increases when analyzing further sub-samples of the data.

2. Sponsorship These data are part of a larger study of the opinions and attitudes of Lethbridge residents conducted by the Citizen Society Research Lab at LCC. This particular set of question was derived from the research interests of Lethbridge College students and faculty.

## Social Issues

(. Same-sex Marriage

A slight majority of Lethbridge residents (54.1\%) continue to support same-sex marriages being treated equal in law with traditional marriages.
(. Abortion Choice

A clear and substantial majority of Lethbridge residents (75.0\%) support a woman's right to choose whether or not to have an abortion.
(2. Capital Punishment

A clear majority of Lethbridge residents (57.6\%) support Canada reintroducing capital punishment for people convicted of first degree murder.
(A. Legal Medical Marijuana

A clear and substantial majority of Lethbridge residents (74.8\%) support marijuana being legal for medical purposes.
Q. Decriminalize Recreational Marijuana

One-third of all Lethbridge residents (35.4\%) support decriminalizing marijuana for recreational purposes.
(A. Legalize Doctor-Assisted Suicide

A majority of Lethbridge residents (61.5\%) support making doctor-assisted suicide legal in Canada.
