Michael thanked the association and union representatives for their reports. He clarified that the Executive Leadership Team plans to discuss the ACIFA 2022 Climate Survey results and the four-year comparative with the Faculty Association Executive before it is shared with the Board of Governors.

#### 6.0 Executive Leadership Team

6.1 President and CEO Report

Brad Donaldson highlighted some of his external and internal activities over the past few months. He hosted a series of Town Halls open to all college employees in the third week in January. On January 19 he attended an announcement at the Galt Museum where the Honorable Dan Vandal, Minster of PrairiesCan, announced that Lethbridge College will receive \$2M to support agriculture research in the Centre for Applied Research, Innovation and Entrepreneurship.

Samantha, Kenny and Brad traveled to Edmonton in December for Team Lethbridge. There were approximately 50 participants from Lethbridge sectors representing various interests. They met with several ministers and Premier Danielle Smith. There were some robust discussions, and the event was informative.

Brad asked if there were any questions. None arose.

## 6.2 The Road to Ready: Strategic Visioning

Brad shared that this is a four-phase process, and he is striking a Steering Committee with representatives from across the college as part of phase 1. Phase 2 will include comprehensive data collection (focus groups, interviews, surveys with internal and external stakeholders) and analysis. Results will be brought forward to the Board of Governors in September and the project will wrap up in October 2023.

A question was raised as to whether the college has an existing strategic plan. Lethbridge College has a strategic framework with a vision, mission and strategies that was last approved in 2020. The strategic direction needs to be reviewed to ensure Lethbridge College is adaptive and responding to changes in a post-pandemic world.

Engaging with the Francophone and Indigenous communities (Red Crow Community College and Saamis Employment Training Association) is important. An invitation may be circulated to the broader community.

Phasing and timelines need to be considered. The working group will advise on timing that works best for communications. In house resources will be utilized. Operational resource planning comprises the final phase.

Perry Stein will join the Steering Committee representing the Board of Governors.

Dr. Kevin Smith advised that the Marketing Major was suspended in 2021 due to low enrolments. An extensive consultative process and review of Alberta post-secondary institutions ensued in consideration of reactivating the program. Marketing program enrolments across the province remain lower than other Business Administration majors. The current Business Administration Diploma majors at Lethbridge College continue to offer first and second year marketing courses and the 2+2 or block transfers for the Business Diploma will continue.
